

Pavilion Update

What a summer it's been! In addition to our successful financial campaign for our pavilion, we have been blessed with more in-kind help from Schmidt Associates, an architectural firm who has prepared state required drawings for our permit, Wes Harrison, a structural engineer and Mattingly General Contractors who will construct the pavilion *AND* provide special shovels for our soon-to-be scheduled ground-breaking ceremony. You may remember other in-kind services previously announced Shirley Cook and Steve Karch are providing site prep and excavating assistance and Rocklane Roofing will install gutters for us. The support that so many members have shown in making gifts and pledges, however, is the foundation upon which the project is being built.

Here's where we stand now. All drawings and related documents required to support our request for the building permit have been completed by the architect, structural engineer and the pavilion task force. Just this week we learned that for a project like ours we can file our request electronically (online) which will expedite that process, and this was completed Thursday August 11.

Our site prep team of Shirley and Steve have met with the project superintendent of the general contractor so once the permit is in hand we will be ready to start construction. The actual time for construction will almost certainly be measured in single digit days as opposed to the months of planning (and head scratching and worrying and prayer!) up to this point.

Thanks to everyone at CPC for both the financial and congregational support you have given. Thanks also to Troop and Pack 88 who gave a generous cash donation and also to the many families in the troop and the pack for their individual contributions.




