These were all new items and were much appreciated. PW will be donating hats, gloves, and scarves in December.





Those sounds you hear are the framing crew of Mattingly General Contractors setting 6 x 6 posts, building the structure and roof, then moving on to setting the forms for the concrete pad and sidewalk connecting the Pavilion to the existing sidewalk. As you know Steve Karch and Shirley Cook provided the excavation and site preparation for the Pavilion on October 1 once we got our permit applications approved. The Pavilion Task Force received confirmation today from Mattingly contractors that construction will start November 1.
