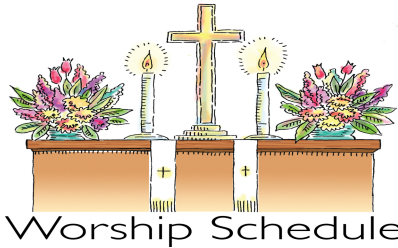

Stewardship is pleased to announce that the twenty year old roof on our building will soon be replaced. Work is scheduled to begin on September 24 and will take 3-5 days.

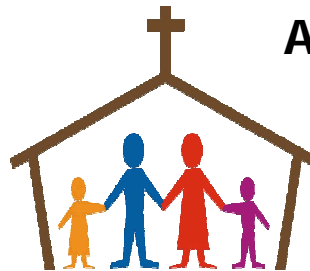
