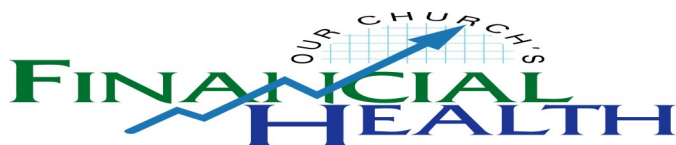

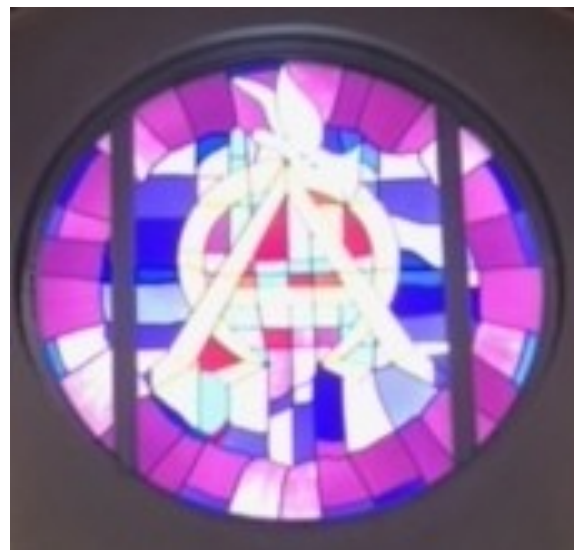

Several people have asked where the "old", "antique" "ugly" collection plates have come from. Well — here's your answer.

Bill Schofield found them in his basement [along with other items that may show up one day]. They were used at **Memorial Presbyterian Church** (Bill's 'home' church) that was at the corner of 11<sup>th</sup> Street and Carrolton Avenue. Now known as the **North Spilt**. The church was built in 1873 and met at that location until 1969. For a few years after that, they met in the chapel of the old First Presbyterian Church at 16<sup>th</sup> and Delaware until it finally closed permanently.

Angel Connection is now part of F. A. R. M. (Fortville Area Resource Mission) F. A. R. M. Is open every Tuesday from 12:30-2:30 for food pickup. They hold a Bible study from 11:30-12:30 prior to the pantry opening. On Thursdays they take food to a low income apartment complex on the north side of Fortville. They have 125 families at the pantry on Tuesdays and around 25 families in the apartments. They also sponsor snack bags for around 45 students in the Mt. Vernon school system to take home for the weekends.

The Presbyterian Women will be touring their facility on June 14th. The facility is located in Fortville Christian Church, 9450 N. 200W
