(Fortville Area Resource Mission)

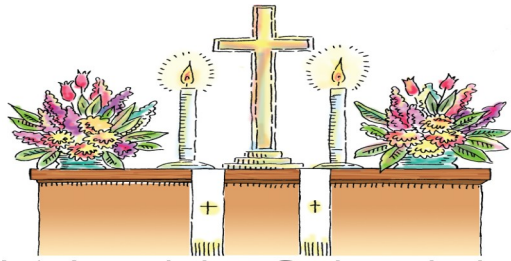
